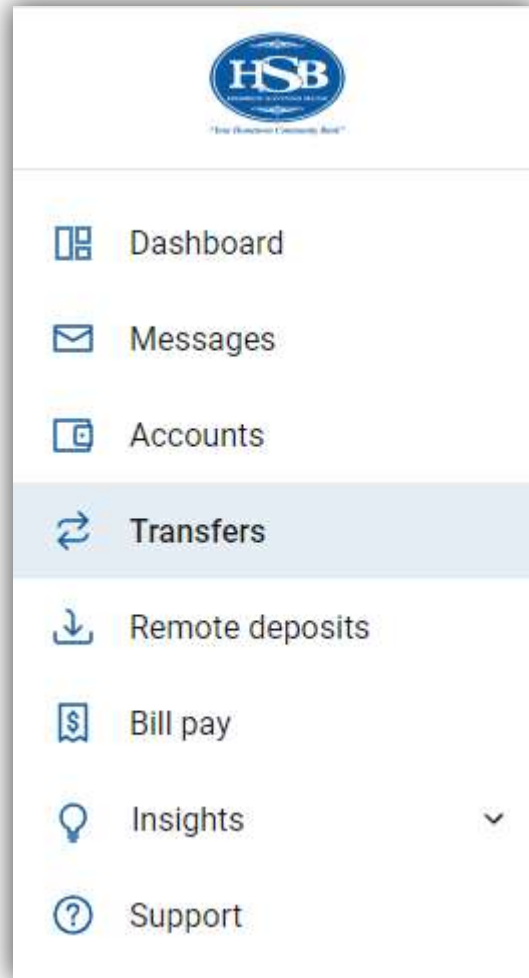


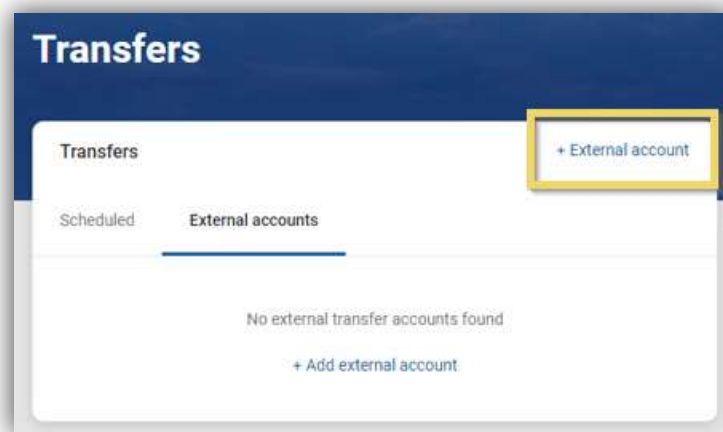
## Setting Up an External Transfer

Login to Online Banking.


Select Transfers from the left-hand menu.



Click +External Account to set up a new external account connection.

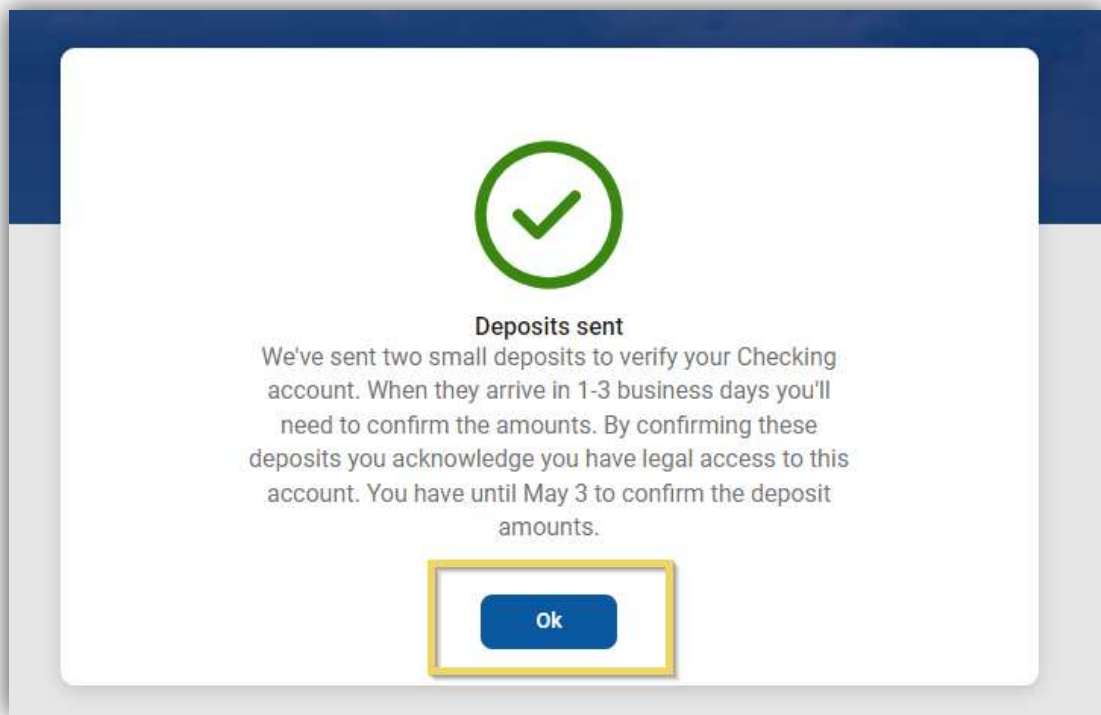


You will be prompted to enter the following information for your account at another financial institution:

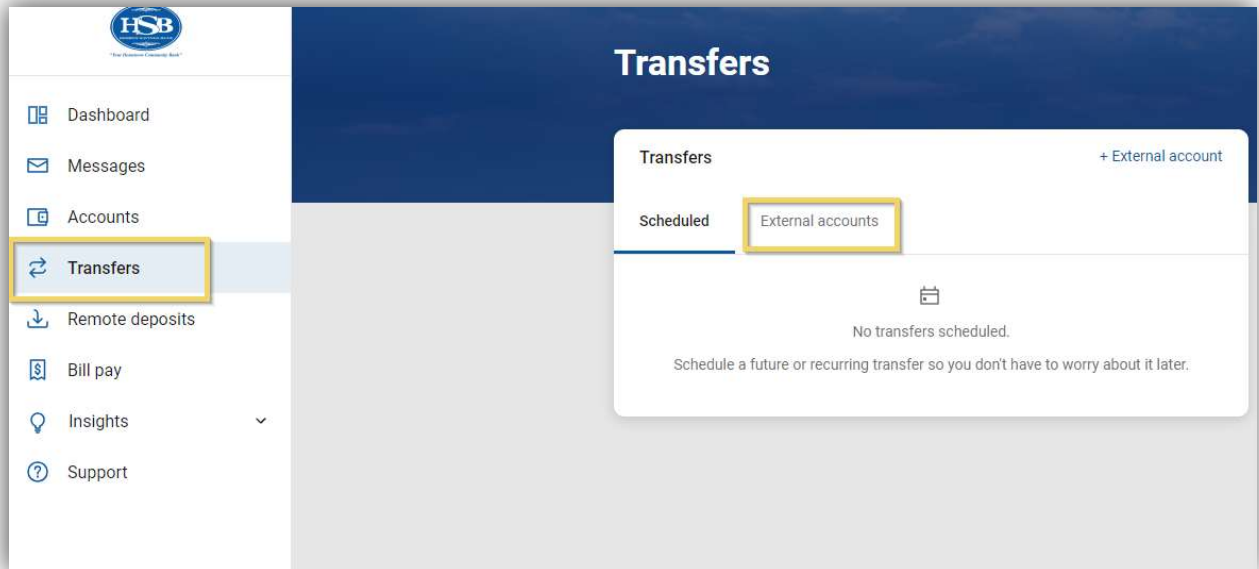

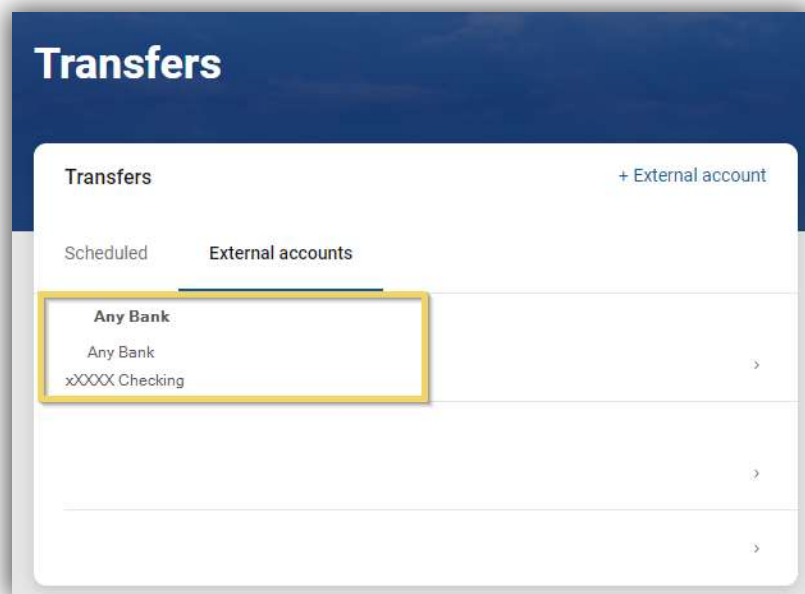
